

CARON® Crochet Cozy Contrast Hat

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MATERIALS

Caron® All Day Wool™ (5 oz/140 g; 80 yds/73 m)

Contrast A Slated (31108) **1 ball or 80 yds/73 m**

Contrast B Sand Dune (31105) **1 ball or 77 yds/70 m**

Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or** size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].



ABBREVIATIONS


Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdchb = Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram).



Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

Hat

With B, ch 11. With A ch 18. Total 29 ch.

1st row: (RS). With A, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 5 ch. 1 hdc in each of next 12 ch. With B, 1 hdc in each of last 11 ch. Turn. 28 sts.

2nd row: With B, ch 2. 1 hdchb in each of next 11 hdc. With A, 1 hdchb in each st to last 5 sc. *Working in front loops only*, 1 sc in each of last 5 sc. Turn.


3rd row: With A, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each of first 5 sc. 1 hdchb in each of next 12 sts. With B, 1 hdchb in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until Hat (at widest point) measures approx 19½" [49.5 cm] when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn end of A.

FINISHING

Using A yarn end, weave through short side of Hat (sc rows) and gather top of Hat tog securely. Sew center back seam, changing to B at color change. Turn back cuff as shown.

Pompom: Wind B around 4 fingers approx 80 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape, 4" [10 cm] diameter. Sew securely to top of Hat.



INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Hat is worked side to side.
- Work with 2 separate balls of yarn and twist 2 colors around each other, where they meet on WS, to avoid a hole.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.
