



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MATERIALS

Red Heart® All in One™ Quilt Motif™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 417 yds/381 m)

Contrast A Vintage (0006)

2 balls or 750 yds/686 m

Contrast B Cultured (0010)

1 ball or 384 yds/351 m

Contrast C Authentic (0012)

1 ball or 384 yds/351 m

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

MEASUREMENT

Approx 38" [96.5 cm] square, excluding fringe.

GAUGES

5 dc blocks = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

Quilt Motif: Approx 9½" [24 cm] square.

INSTRUCTIONS

BLANKET

Notes:

- All in One Quilt Motif is worked diagonally from corner to corner.
- Each C2C block in Crochet Diagram is shown in shade sequence that occurs directly from the ball.
- Each Color change aligns with specific rows in the Quilt Motif using 8 Color changes in total for each Quilt Motif.
- Quilt Motif begins with Color 1 from center of pull-skein, leaving a 4" [10 cm] tail to weave in.
 - Rows 1 to 4 will be Color 1.
 - Rows 5 to 7 will be Color 2.
 - Rows 8 and 9 will be Color 3.
 - Rows 10 to 12 will be Color 2.
 - Rows 13 and 14 will be Color 4.
 - Rows 15 to 17 will be Color 2.
 - Rows 18 and 19 will be Color 1.
 - Rows 20 to 23 will be Color 2.
- If too much color is left before color change, pull back some sts and slightly loosen gauge to re-work sts and finish at color change. If too little color is left, pull back some sts and slightly tighten gauge to re-work sts and finish at color change.
- When Quilt Motif is complete, cut yarn where Color 2 ends (final color repeat at end of 23rd row), leaving approx 46" [117 cm] tail at end of Quilt Motif for seaming. Begin next Quilt Motif with Color 1 and repeat 23 rows for each Quilt Motif.

Quilt Motif

Make 8 in A, and 4 each in B and C.

With Color 1, ch 6.

(See Crochet Diagram on page 3).

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each of last 2 ch. Turn. 1 block made.

2nd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch – beg block made. (Sl st. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp – block made. Turn. 2 blocks complete.

3rd row: Beg block. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 3 blocks.

4th row: Beg block. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 4 blocks. Color 1 complete.

Beg with Color 2, on row 5 of Crochet Diagram, rep last row until 12th row of Chart is complete, working color changes as shown. 12 blocks.

Keeping cont of color changes shown on Crochet Diagram, proceed as follows to dec corner:


13th row: (RS). Sl st in each of first 3 dc. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. Sl st in last ch-3 sp. **Turn.**

Keeping cont of color changes shown on Crochet Diagram, rep last row until 1 block rem. 23 rows are complete. Fasten off at end of Color 2, leaving long tail (approx 46" [117 cm]) for seaming. Quilt Motif should measure approx 9½" [24 cm] square.

FINISHING


Pin Motifs to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Following Assembly Diagram, sew Quilt Motifs tog using Flat Seam.

ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM




FLAT SEAM



Fringe

Cut strands of A, B and C 10" [25.5 cm] long. Taking 1 strand of each color tog (3 strands), fold in half and knot into fringe, having one fringe bundle between each block around outside edge of Blanket. Trim fringe evenly.



CROCHET DIAGRAM
