ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dec = Decreasing

K = Knit

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]

2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest

XS/S 42" [106.5 cm]

M 44" [112 cm]

L 50" [127 cm]

XL 54" [137 cm]

2/3XL 58" [147.5 cm]

4/5XL 62" [157.5 cm]

GAUGE

8 stitches (sts) and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for **XS/S**. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written **XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL)**. Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket Patchwork™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Sizes U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) and U.S. 11 (8 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® stitch holder set.

BACK

With smaller needles cast on **41 (**43-49-53-57-61**) stitches (sts).
1st row: (Right Side – RS). Knit 1 (K1). *Purl 1 (P1). K1. Repeat (Rep) from * to end of row.
2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a Wrong Side (WS) row.

Next row: (WS). Rib across **19** (**21-23-25-27-29**) sts. Knit into front and back of next st (Kfb). Rib to end of row. **42** (**44-50-54-58-62**) sts.

Change to larger needles.

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: Purl.**

Rep last 2 rows for stocking st until Back from beginning (beg) measures **22½** (**22½-23-23-23½-24**)" [**57** (**57-58-58-59.6-61**) cm], ending on a purl row.

Final row: Cast off **13** (**14-16-18-19-21**) sts. Break yarn. Slip next **16** (**16-18-18-20-20**) sts onto a st holder. Rejoin yarn and cast off remaining (rem) **13** (**14-16-18-19-21**) sts.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.
 Rep last 2 rows for stocking st until Front from beg measures **20½** (**20½-21-21-21½-22**)" [**52** (**52-53.5-53.5-54.5-56**) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape left neck: 1st row: (RS). **K14** (**15-17-19-20-22**). K2tog (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows. **13** (**14-16-18-19-21**) sts rem.

6th row: Purl.

Cast off.

Shape right neck: With RS facing, leave center **10** (**10-12-12-14-14**) sts on st holder. Rejoin yarn to rem **16** (**17-19-21-22-24**) sts.

1st row: (RS). Ssk. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd to 6th rows: Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more. **13** (**14-16-18-19-21**) sts rem. Cast off.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles cast on **23** (**23-25-25-27-29**) sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a RS row.

Next row: (WS). *Rib across **5** (**5-5-5-7-7**) sts. Kfb. Rep from * twice more. Rib to end of row. **26** (**26-28-28-30-32**) sts.

Change to larger needles.

Work 2 rows in stocking st.

Next row: (RS – increase row). K1. Kfb. Knit to last st. Kfb. K1.

Work 5 rows even.

Rep last 6 rows 4 times more. **36** (**36-38-38-40-42**) sts.

Continue (Cont) even in stocking st until Sleeve from beg measures **18** (**18-17½-17½-17-17**)" [**45.5** (**45.5-44.5-44.5-43-43**) cm], ending on a purl row.

Cast off. Fold sleeve in half and mark center point of cast off edge (this will match to shoulder seam when sewing on sleeves).

FINISHING

Sew right shoulder seam.

Neckband: With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 6 sts down left front neck edge. **K10** (**10-12-12-14-14**) from front st holder. Pick up and knit 6 sts up right front neck edge. **K16** (**16-18-18-20-20**) from back st holder, decreasing (dec) 1 st at center. **37** (**37-41-41-45-45**) sts.

1st row: (WS). *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

2nd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd to 5th rows: Rep last 2 rows once more, then 1st row once. Cast off in ribbing. Sew left shoulder and neckband seam.

Place markers on side edges of Front and Back **9** (**9-9½-9½-10-10½**)" [**23** (**23-24.5-24.5-25.5-26.5**) cm] down from shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves between markers, matching marker at center of cast off edge of sleeve to shoulder seam.

Sew side and sleeve seams.
