Set of 4 size U.S. 13 (9 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Susan Bates® stitch marker. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

SIZES

To fit U.S. Women’s Shoe Sizes

- S** 4-6½
- M** 7-9½
- L** 10-12½

Finished foot length

- S** 9" [23 cm]
- M** 10" [25.5 cm]
- L** 11" [28 cm]



GAUGE

9 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ing)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dec = Decrease(ed)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

P2togtbl = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

SIIP = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn held in back

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for **S**. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written **S (M-L)**. Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

With A, cast on **24 (28-28)** sts **loosely**. Divide sts onto 3 needles as follows: 8 sts on 1st needle and **8 (10-10)** sts each on 2nd and 3rd needles. PM and join to beg working in rnds.

1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing 5 times more. 6 rnds total. **Do not** break A.

Note: Carry color not in use loosely up side of work.

Join B and proceed as follows:

*With B, knit 3 rnds.

With A, knit 2 rnds.

Rep from * once more. Break B.

With A only, proceed as follows:

Knit 2 rnds.

Next rnd: (Dec rnd). *K**4 (5-5)**. K2tog. Rep from * around. **20 (24-24)** sts.

Knit 6 rnds even.

Next rnd: (Dec rnd). *K**3 (4-4)**. K2tog. Rep from * around. **16 (20-20)** sts.

Knit even in rnds until work from cast-on edge measures 9" [23 cm] (or desired leg length).

Divide for Heel flap: Slip **2 (4-4)** sts from 2nd needle onto end of 1st needle. Leave rem **8 (10-10)** sts on 2nd and 3rd needles for instep. Break A.

Join B and proceed working Heel flap in rows on 1st needle as follows:

1st row: (RS). *SIIP. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: SIIP. Purl to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows **3 (4-4)** times more.

Shape Heel

1st row: (RS). SLP. K3 (4-4). ssk. K1. Turn.

2nd row: SLP. P1. P2togtbl. P1. Turn.

Size S only: 3rd row: SLP. K2. ssk. Turn.

4th row: SLP. P2. P2togtbl. Turn. 4 sts.

Sizes M and L only: 3rd row: SLP. K2. ssk. K1. Turn.

4th row: SLP. P3. P2togtbl. P1. Turn. 6 sts.

All sizes: 5th row: Knit. Break B.

Shape instep: With A, pick up and knit 4 (6-6) sts up left side edge of Heel flap. K8 (10-10) sts on 2nd needle (instep). Pick up and knit 4 (6-6) sts down right side edge of Heel flap. Knit first 2 (3-3) sts from heel onto end of 3rd needle. 20 (28-28) sts are now divided as 6 (9-9) sts on 1st and 3rd needles and 8 (10-10) sts on 2nd needle.

Beg of rnd is now at center of Heel as follows:

1st rnd: 1st needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. **2nd needle:** Knit.

3rd needle: K1. ssk. Knit to end of needle. 2 sts dec.

2nd rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds 1 (3-3) time(s) more to 16 (20-20) sts, divided as 4 (5-5) sts on 1st and 3rd needles and 8 (10-10) sts on 2nd needle.

FOOT

1st rnd: Knit.

Cont knitting even in rnds until foot from **picked up sts at Heel** measures 7 (8-9)" [18 (20.5-23) cm]. Break A.

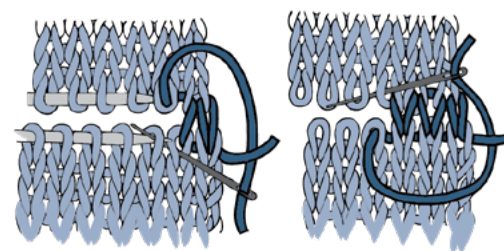
With B, knit 2 rnds.

Shape toe: 1st rnd: 1st needle: Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. **2nd needle:** ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. **3rd needle:** ssk. Knit to end of needle. 12 (16-16) sts. 4 sts dec.

2nd rnd: Knit.

3rd rnd: As 1st rnd. 8 (12-12) sts.

Knit sts of 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Graft 2 sets of 4 (6-6) sts tog (see Diagram below).



GRAFTING
